

2. That all proceeds from the additional \$25.00 increase in the wheel tax shall be placed in the General Debt Service to be used only for the following specified items: construction of a new Lebanon High School and to acquire property for a new Watertown High School.

3. The additional \$25.00 increase in the wheel tax shall take effect on the first (1st) day of January, 2010 unless the citizens of Wilson County have successfully petitioned the Wilson County Election Commission to hold a special referendum.

4. The additional \$25.00 increase in the wheel tax shall expire on July 1 of the first (1st) year after the entire debt, including principal and interest, for the items listed above has been fully retired. At that time, the wheel tax shall reduce to the rate of \$25.00, as originally adopted by the Wilson County Commission, and from that date forward.

5. This resolution shall have no effect unless it is approved by a 2/3 vote of the Board of County Commissioners of Wilson County, Tennessee at two (2) consecutive scheduled meetings.

6. This resolution shall have no effect on the original \$25.00 wheel tax previously imposed by the County Commission of Wilson County, Tennessee.

7. That the funding mechanism used to construct the new Lebanon High School and to purchase property for the new Watertown High School shall be handled and completed by the Wilson County Finance Office.

8. That the Wilson County Clerk shall be entitled to receive and collect the statutory fee allowed for the wheel tax.

9. The tax herein levied and the payment of the privilege tax imposed hereunder shall be subject to the same terms and conditions contained in Section 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 as set out in the original wheel tax resolution adopted by vote of this County Commission on May 18, 1987 and July 21, 1987.
